YEAR 13 ACADEMIC PROGRESS CHECK 1

I hope you find the enclosed progress check helpful in tracking your child's progress. This is useful to gauge where your child is currently at with their learning ahead of the mock examinations which take place from Thursday 5th December to Wednesday 11th December. Please find below the mock examination timetable for information. Following the mock examinations, we will publish the next progress check on **Tuesday 28th January**, and this will be followed up by a Virtual Year 13 Parents Evening on **Wednesday 12th February**.

December Internal Mock Examinations

Personalised exam timetables including rooming and seat numbers can now be found on students' Myhighcliffe. Please encourage your child to check this information ahead of the exam period. Students will be granted study leave throughout the mock exam period and we expect students to return to lessons on Thursday 12th December. Teaching staff will be available to all students for drop ins / revision support in normal classrooms during their timetabled lessons throughout the study leave period.

We have asked students who study vocational subjects (BTEC/CTEC courses) to use the time gained to ensure that they are fully up to date with all components of their courses and related coursework. Some vocational courses have external examinations in January, and so time can be used for revision and preparation for upcoming examinations.

Lessons in all Art, Design and Technology (Da Vinci) subject areas will continue as normal during the mock exam period and the expectation is that students attend lessons around their exams. This is to help support students to keep on track and meet their upcoming examined coursework deadlines. Students who are studying two Art, Design and Technology subjects should be able to attend the majority of lessons so they can continue working on their projects.

University Applications

We encourage students who are sure about their choices and who have finalised their personal statement, to send their application by the end of autumn term. This allows students to then focus on their studies with a clear goal in mind.

Students have been advised that they should not rush their application if they feel they are not yet ready. **The final deadline for UCAS applications is set by UCAS, which is Wednesday 29th January 2025.**

Please be aware that attendance at tutor time on a **Monday and Tuesday** remains compulsory for Year 13. During this time, we deliver whole school and Sixth Form messages and provide future pathways and wellness support. Students also continue to attend a one to one tutorial with their tutor every half term to help them remain focused.
