Dear Parents / Guardians,

As we commence the new school year, please see below for information about how classes are organised in the Maths department.

Year 7:

- Students are all in mixed prior attainment groups.
- The number associated with the set does not relate to prior ability (for example 7Ma1/x has the same prior attainment profile as 7Ma3/x).

Year 8:

- Students are all in mixed prior attainment groups.
- The number associated with the set does not relate to prior ability (for example 8Ma1/x has the same prior attainment profile as 8Ma3/x).

Year 9:

- Students are banded based on their most likely trajectory towards either the Higher or Foundation tier of entry at GCSE.
- This is something that will be fluid across the course of the next three academic years so their group in Year 9 does not fix them to a particular tier of entry in Year 11.
- The content covered throughout the majority of the year is very similar, the pace of lessons is the main differentiator.
- This means that groups Ma1/x, Ma2/x, Ma3/x, Ma1/y, Ma2/y are in the Higher band and are roughly equivalent in terms of prior attainment profiles; groups ending in Ma3/y, Ma4/y, Ma4/x or Ma5/x are in the Foundation band and are roughly equivalent in terms of prior attainment profiles.

Year 10:

- Students are banded based on their most likely trajectory towards either the Higher or Foundation tier of entry at GCSE.
- This is something that continues to be in Key Stage 4 so their group in Year 10 does not fix them to a particular tier of entry in Year 11.
- This means that groups Ma1/x, Ma2/x, Ma3/x, Ma1/y, Ma2/y are in the Higher band and are roughly equivalent in terms of prior attainment profiles; groups ending in Ma3/y, Ma4/y, Ma4/x or Ma5/x are in the Foundation band and are roughly equivalent in terms of prior attainment profiles.















Year 11:

- Students are banded based on their most likely trajectory towards either the Higher or Foundation tier of entry at GCSE.
- This means that groups Ma1/x, Ma2/x, Ma3/x, Ma1/y, Ma2/y are in the Higher band and are roughly equivalent in terms of prior attainment profiles; groups ending in Ma3/y, Ma4/y, Ma4/x or Ma5/x are in the Foundation band and are roughly equivalent in terms of prior attainment profiles.
- Continuous assessment, December and March mocks will solidify the students tier of entry.
