Year 11 Geography Swanage Fieldtrip 2023

As part of the GCSE Geography course, students have to collect data in both a human and physical setting, which is part of their paper 3 examination in the summer. This is worth 30% of their Geography GCSE. Therefore, we are pleased to be offering a fieldtrip to Swanage where students will investigate coastal processes, management and land use around the town. This fieldtrip will also support their learning in the Coasts topic.

To ensure students gain the highest support possible, we will be working alongside the Outdoor Education Service - Leeson House, who are experts in this field and have worked alongside AQA to lead quality fieldtrips, specifically in relation to the GCSE Geography Paper 3.

Your child will be going to Swanage on either Monday 25th September 2023 OR Monday 2nd October 2023.

On each day we will be leaving school at 8.00am, therefore students need to be at school by 7.45am to be registered. We will be returning to school at approximately 4.30pm.

- 11Ge1/A (Mr Chant) and 11Ge2/A (Mr Coyle) will be going on Monday 25th September 2023
- 11Ge1/C (Miss Stewart) and 11Ge1/D (Mr Chant) will be going on Monday 2nd October 2023
- 11Ge1/B (Mr Houghton) your child will be going on EITHER Monday 25th September OR Monday 2nd October. Your child will be told which day they will be attending the trip in their Geography lesson.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch and plenty of drink for the day. Please ensure your child brings/wears sun cream and wears suitable clothing (we will be collecting data on the beach and in the town). Students also need to bring writing equipment; the Outdoor Education centre will provide clipboards and booklets. The cost of this fieldtrip is £27, which covers the cost of transport to and from Swanage, insurances and the expertise from the Outdoor Education Service. Payment should be made using the school's on-line WisePay facility. Please make a note of your WisePay receipt reference, as you will need to provide this on the attached medical consent form. Receipts are generated automatically on WisePay and sent to the email address you supply when making the payment.

Please note - student poor behaviour and/or attendance could mean your child's place on the trip is revoked. You may not be entitled to a refund.
