You are invited to our **Sixth Form Open Evening on Tuesday 3rd October from 5.30pm – 8.00pm**. Our aim for the evening is to give you an insight into the type of high-quality experiences you will encounter as a student here.

During the evening, there will be an information seminar at 6pm, repeated at 7pm in the Hall. You will also have the opportunity to speak to teachers about the courses on offer and meet students already on the courses who can talk about their experiences at Highcliffe Sixth Form.

Our excellent examination results maintain Highcliffe's position as a leading provider of Sixth Form education in the Christchurch, New Forest and Bournemouth areas and confirm Ofsted's judgment that "the Sixth Form is a real strength of the school." This is reflected in the very good results achieved in 2023.

We are exceptionally proud of our ongoing record of students progressing to top Universities. Almost a third of the year group are now going to one of the prestigious Russell Group research universities such as Southampton, Cardiff, Bristol, or other top-ranked universities. Many students are going onto degree courses with national reputations for excellence at local universities including Bournemouth Arts University, AECC and Winchester University, or on to apprenticeships/degree apprenticeships with major companies including JP Morgan, BAE and IBM.

As mature young adults, the views of Sixth Form students exert considerable influence over the way their Sixth Form works. We have a strong student voice and leadership team. We are currently putting in place a range of initiatives, as a result of students' feedback and with their support, to further improve the learning experience. These are all focussed on enhancing the College/University-style independent learning culture in the Sixth Form, which makes it a very different experience to studying at GCSE level and excellent preparation for university or employment at age 18.

When asked what they believe makes their Sixth Form special and successful, Highcliffe students point to the quality of teaching, the excellent relationships with staff, small class sizes and the many enrichment opportunities available to them; but mainly to the warm, supportive, welcoming and mature adult ethos of the students themselves and the staff who work with them. Even for students who studied at Highcliffe for their GCSEs, the adult atmosphere of the Sixth Form is surprisingly different to the main school.
