## Dorset Waterpark, Wareham – Thursday 18th July 2024

As part of Activities Week, Year 8 students have the opportunity to visit Dorset Waterpark, Wareham on **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> July 2024**. Your child has expressed an interest in taking part in this activity.

During the day, students will be involved on both the waterpark and the mud runs. There are 60 allocated places available for the day with 67 students requesting to go, these places will be awarded on a first come first served basis. **Students should be confident in the water, however, will be expected to wear a buoyancy aid at all times in the waterpark.** Students must be in school ready to depart by 8.40am and will return by the end of the school day.

Students should bring-A bag to carry wet/muddy clothes Clothing for the waterpark – swimwear and towel Clothing for the mud run – old clothes and a spare pair of trainers (these will get extremely wet and muddy) Change of clothing to travel in Packed lunch and drink

The cost of the trip is £42 to cover admission and insurance costs. Should you wish your child to take part in this activity, please make payment via the school's WisePay facility by Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> April. The trip is available for payment through the school's WisePay system. Please make a note of your WisePay receipt reference.
