Year 9 Key Stage 4 Options and Progression Evening

We would like to invite you to the Year 9 Options and Progression Evening on Wednesday 5th March at 5:30pm (finishing at 7pm).

The purpose of this evening is to provide students and parents with the information that they need so they are equipped to make informed and confident decisions about their option choices and how these link to their future education and career plans. The evening will have two parts, each of 40 minutes:

A talk in the Main Hall outlining the options process and the requirements of the different courses - compulsory and optional as well as offering advice about how options link to careers Sixth Form choices and future education.

An opportunity to visit subjects, careers adviser and Sixth Form in the gym and performance hall, where you will be able to ask questions relating to the make-up of different courses, find out about subject content and suitability.

Tutor groups 9.1 to 9.5 will start in the Hall for a talk whilst tutor groups 9.6 to 9.9 will start in the gym and performance hall and then move to the Hall at 6:10pm.


