



## LETTER FROM THE GOVERNORS

- Encouraging and facilitating your child's involvement in extra-curricular sport and clubs.
- Actively encouraging your child to participate in trips, visits and other extra-curricular activities
- Where applicable, ensuring that your child attends Catch Up and Booster classes.
- Being supportive of the school's processes and management structure by raising any concerns to the right member of staff and escalating where appropriate.
- Providing advice and guidance on appropriate usage of mobile phones and social media

We also seek the support of our parent community in the following areas:

- Being a Governor of the school.
- Providing opportunities for work experience and work-related projects or activities.
- Being able and willing to make a voluntary and valuable contribution to School Funds.
