School Stationery Shop

The school operates a supply shop from the Library. Students will be able to buy various items (a pack of pens/pencils not singles, rulers etc.) or a ready-stocked pencil case.

All students in Years 7 to 11 must have the following basic equipment daily:

- School Organiser/Planner
- Black pens (at least 3)
- Purple Pen
- Pencils (at least 3)
- Whiteboard Pen - Black - Fine Tip
- Sharpener
- Eraser
- Glue stick
- Geometry set (optional)
- Ruler (15cm or 30cm)
- Colouring pencils (not felt tip pens)
- Scientific calculator (recommended Casio fx83GT PLUS or fx85GT PLUS – solar)
- Student ID Card / Catering Card (will be provided to new starters at the beginning of term)
- Notebook (optional)

Please note - Sixth Form students will require a graphics calculator

Students can purchase a clear pencil case (required for internal and public examinations) ready-stocked with equipment from the school library at a reasonable price.

The following learning resources may be required of all students in Years 7 to 11 by arrangement/request in certain lessons:

- The course textbook where issued
- Exercise book or work folder
- Oxford Mini Dictionary and Thesaurus (recommend ISBN: 978-0199692637)
- Plus, any learning resources, revision notes, or independent work requested in advance by the teacher for a particular lesson

On certain days students will be required to bring their PE kit and/or Technology aprons, depending on their timetable.

We recommend students bring in their own water bottle to keep hydrated whilst at school. There are water fountains to refill their bottles and whilst there is water for sale at the catering station, we hope by using their own water bottle this will reduce plastic waste.
