Results Day

Centre discovers error made on submission and/or believes the awarding body made an error when issuing the grade

Student is concerned about a grade awarded

Student must speak to a member of staff for advice and review the Centre TAG Policy, Sources of Evidence Used and Adjustments and Mitigations due to Special Circumstances.

Student accepts that the grade is correct.
No review is necessary.

Student believes that the centre has failed to follow procedures correctly and consistently or has made an administrative error and would like to request a Centre Review of grade.

Complete Online Centre Review Form. (Student Understands that the grade can be LOWERED, RAISED or STAY THE SAME)

CENTRE UNDERTAKES REVIEW OF GRADE

Review outcome supports original grade.

Review outcome finds an error was made in deciding grade.

Student notified and information about next step provided.

Student accepts the grade is correct.
No further action required.

Student wishes to proceed to stage 2 Appeal.
Complete online Stage 2 Appeal Form

Centre submits Stage 2 Appeal and collated evidence to the awarding organisation.

Centre submits an error correction request to the awarding organisation. Amended result notified by school email

Awarding organisation reject appeal. Student is notified and advised of how to apply for a Procedural Review if required.

Appeal is upheld and results in a grade change.
Student is notified.
