### **Sixth Form: A2 start up and progression into Year 13**

A2 courses began on **Monday 9<sup>th</sup> June**. We are currently checking attendance and it has come to our attention that some students are not attending all their lessons.

May we remind you that you must continue studying **ALL** your subjects until the end of term, even if you are not planning to study them in Year 13, in case you do not get the results you are expecting in August.

In order to progress into Y13, you need to have:

- Good attendance and ATL including during the A2 start-up period.
- You also need to achieve a minimum of 3 grade Es at AS Level. For BTEC or Diploma courses, you need to have completed and passed all Year 12 assignments.

As discussed at Future Pathways Day on Friday, make sure you make the most of your time between now and September to enhance your application, including volunteering for one of our mentoring or leadership roles, studying a Future Learn online course or arranging some work experience.

Ideally you should arrange the work experience outside of school hours. If you are planning to do work experience during your study periods, please make sure you see Mrs White or Mrs Bower to arrange the necessary permission and paperwork. Thank you, Mrs Karanja and Miss Swan.


