

Year 11 controlled assessment will take place for x half on 17/11/16 (Thursday) and y half on 18/11/16 (Friday). The rooms for each science class are below:



INTERNET SAFETY DAY: WEDNESDAY 16TH NOVEMBER 2016 (MRD)

On Wednesday 16th November, you will be attending an internet safety session led by the Police in the hall.

Period 1	8	How to use social networking sites safely.
Period 2	7	How to be safe: Do you know who you are talking to?
Period 3	10	Learning about the laws surrounding internet use and the consequences of breaching it.
Period 4	9	Do you know the law and consequences surrounding "Sexting"?
Period 5	11	How to use the internet safely for financial use? (Online banking, protecting yourself against internet fraud and the use of personal data.

What to do when it is your year group's session?

- Go to your normal teaching room and wait for your teacher to register you.
- You will then be asked to go to the hall and line up as if you were going into assembly.
