**Year 7 Exams (WES/JHG)**


**Year 7 Exams - Please remember the following tips to help you be prepared for your exams this week:**

## Stonehenge Summer Solstice 2017 Notice

Following recent terrorist related incidents across the UK, additional security measures will be in place at Summer Solstice this year. We are working closely with Wiltshire Police to ensure the safety of all visitors and, as a result, only small bags (approx. 30 x 25 x 15cm) will be permitted into the Monument Field and searches will be conducted. We are strongly advising visitors to only bring essential items with them and leave valuables at home.

I would also like to remind you that Summer Solstice is an alcohol-free occasion and we would be hugely grateful if you could communicate this to any year groups you feel this will impact upon: we are pleased that more young people have been attending the Summer Solstice, but we think that it's important that they're aware of this fact and that their expectations are managed. Any person attempting to take alcohol into the monument field will have this confiscated, any person consuming alcohol within the monument field will be asked to leave, and any person who appears drunk at the entry point will not be permitted to enter the monument field.

Please also note that under 16s are only permitted to attend if accompanied by a responsible adult and illegal drugs are illegal at Stonehenge as they are anywhere else. The police will be on site and will take action against anyone breaking the law.
