You will need to form a team to compete to crack the ciphers, unscramble code, discuss the implications of the science, the research and the effect on the wider world.

Your team does not need to be in school to submit to the online forums/compete but you must register on the website by Friday 30th June

Team Registration is open already!

Prizes (in the form of amazon vouchers worth up to £300) will be awarded at the end of the challenge!


Students participating in this event are required all day Thursday in the main hall. You will need to be in school uniform during the day. During the event, you will need to wear

THE SETI CIPHER CHALLENGE 2017

#BreakTheCode

Once again the University of Southampton is running an online forum-based challenge for students across the UK. Just like in previous years, scientists at the University are receiving scrambled messages, but this year they appear to be different.... It seems like whoever is sending the messages is trying to warn the Earth of future dangers!

Control room scientists at the University need help decoding this strange information which appears to be coming from an unexplained radio wave source in the basement of the Physics and Astronomy building.

Can you help the scientists figure out how to save the Earth before we make the same mistakes?

During this 4 day challenge, scrambled data will be released to registered student teams via the challenge website. Teams will be awarded points based on the speed, accuracy and novelty of their submissions to the website forums.

There will be two forums that teams can participate in. The first is a science forum reserved for scientific discussion of the messages. The second is a media forum where teams submit news articles, videos, songs and other novel ideas.

The competition will run from 9am-6pm from the 10th-13th July and is open to students aged 14-18 years at schools/colleges in the UK. Note that GCSE students aged 14-15 will be scored separately to AS/A-level students aged 16-18.

Students teams should register on the website before Friday 30th June.
