


# Year 7 Clay Dragons

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## Some of your learning will include:

-  Investigating mythical dragons to inspire creative thinking - helping to build on your knowledge around dragons and their cultural meanings.
-  Develop your shading skills to develop a broader knowledge of the key features of a dragon, considering textures and colour.
-  Build on your technical knowledge and skills whilst working in clay developing your subject specific vocabulary.
-  Construct a clay head pinch pot structure, developing skills working in the third-dimension.
-  Learning to adapt designs whilst working on final outcome.
